The ever-popular TdA has a new title this year, DTdA, and will be led by members of MTRAC and RSA and NASA Directors, such as MSFC Center of Operations Director, Mr. Steve Doering, to tour the Redstone Arsenal by bicycle!

This ride roughly follows the historical railroad route around the southern part of the arsenal, making a loop along Dodd, Buxton, and Patton Rds and features a trip through the Army Test Area 1 (TA1) and the NASA test area. The route returns north along Patton Rd, well after most traffic has left the arsenal.

- The ride is mostly flat, ~ 18 miles long with a 22-25 mile options
- All adult MSFC or RSA personnel and escorted guests are welcome to participate.
- Bring a water bottle; a water stop will be provided mid-way thru the ride.
- The ride is also approved by the MWR.
- **Helmets and bright reflective vests are Mandatory** on the Arsenal.
